DOWN TOWN KIDS CITY

The project gets the 10 to 13 old kids familiar with customs and traditions of the countries from all over the world and encourages them to develop their cross-cultural thinking and tolerance. The camp is held in the Estonian capital city - Tallinn.

07.08 - 21.08

DOWN TOWN KIDS COUNTRY

The volunteers will be providing 10 - 13 yo kids with cross-cultural learning through informal methods of teaching and working in small group techniques. The camp is held in Vaibla in the South of Estonia.

25.06 - 09.07

DOWN TOWN ENG

The project gets 14 to 17 years old teens familiar with national traditions of the countries from all over the world, encourages them to develop their global thinking and individual initiative as well as tolerance and resistance to xenophobia and ethnic hatred. The camp is held in Tallinn.

26.07 - 07.08

DOWN TOWN MULTI

The project gets 14 to 17 years old teens familiar with national traditions of the countries from all over the world. This shift targets particularly those youngsters, who do not speak English but other languages. Camp has 3 working languages: French, German and Spanish; and is located in Tallinn.

10.08 - 20.08

The project is organized by "In Down Town" and "Alternative Language Programs Satellite". The aim is to introduce the diversity of world cultures to the youth and provide them with good practices in intercultural communication using the learning-by-doing method. The topic of the project is Indigenous Languages. Within the theme, camp participants guided by international volunteers are going to discuss issues important for personal and social development.
